

- Heidenau-Birkwitz ferry: Right Elbe: steep and difficult to roll on (cobblestones) Left Elbe: steep and in poor condition (concrete slabs)
  Pirna - Copitz ferry:
- Right Elbe: bumpy pavement and very steep Left Elbe: poor condition
- **Pötzscha Stadt Wehlen ferry:** Right Elbe: bumpy pavement and very steep Left Elbe: bumpy pavement and very steep

## • Ferry Kurort Rathen:

Right Elbe: wheelchair accessible, sloping embankment (ramp-like with 13% gradient)

Left Elbe: wheelchair-accessible, sloping embankment (ramp-like with 6% gradient), sandstone pavement

## • Königstein ferry:

Right Elbe: very good wheelchair access, gradient approx. 6% Left Elbe: very easy to roll on, gradient approx. 6%

- Ferry National Park Bad Schandau railway station Bad Schandau: Right Elbe: wheelchair-accessible, ramp with 6% gradient Left Elbe: wheelchair-accessible, sandstone paving in the lower section, bumpy in places
- Krippen Postelwitz ferry: Right Elbe: very easy to roll on, gradient approx. 6 % Left Elbe: 2023 under reconstruction (temporary stop), completion 2024, then very easy to roll on, gradient approx. 6%

 Ferry stop Hirschmühle - Schmilka: Right Elbe: wheelchair-accessible, bumpy sandstone pavement, with > 4% gradient

Left Elbe: suitable for wheelchairs, ramp with 7% incline, rough **stone paving** 

• Ferry stop Schöna - Hřensko:

Right Elbe: not suitable for wheelchairs, long stairs with several steps and subway

Left Elbe: not suitable for wheelchairs, long stairs
